
Question 4

A cable attached to the top of a pole as shown below carries a 3000 lb tension force.

- What is the moment vector this causes about the base of the pole?
- What is the overall magnitude of the moment about the base of the pole?



$$F_{x} = \left[Q, 15, 0\right] f_{t}$$

$$F_{x} = 3000 \left(\frac{3}{21.4}\right) = 420.08 \text{ lbs}$$

$$F_{y} = 3000 \left(\frac{-15}{21.4}\right) = -2109.42 \text{ lbs}$$

$$F_{z} = 3000 \left(\frac{-15}{21.4}\right) = -2109.42 \text{ lbs}$$

$$M_{\circ} = \sqrt{(-31506.3)^{2} + (-6301.2)^{2}} = 37,130 + 165$$
